- 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- **3** credits in mathematics (Grade 9, Grade 10 and 1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 credits in science
- 1 credit in technological education(Grade 9 or Grade 10)
- 1 credit in Canadian history
- 1 credit in Canadian geography
- 1 credit in arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in career studies

0.5 credit in civics

- 1 credits from the STEM-related course group
 - business studies
 - computer studies
 - cooperative education
 - mathematics (in addition to the 3 compulsory credits currently required)
 - science (in addition to the 2 compulsory credits currently required)
 - technological education (in addition to the 1 compulsory credit required)

In addition, students must complete:

- 13 optional credits
- **40** hours of community involvement activities

Note: Starting in September 2025, students must earn a new financial literacy graduation requirement as part of the compulsory Grade 10 mathematics course. Students will need to achieve a mark of 70% or higher to pass this new requirement and earn the high school diploma.
